Installing the TT-HedgeHunter (EA) Expert Advisor on the MetaTrader4 Platform

NOTE: This tutorial contains instructions for both **U.S. and Non-U.S. Subscribers** and you will also find the “Video” version of this guide in the “Education” section of the TrendTrimmer.com website.

Prior to beginning the installation of the “TT-HedgeHunter Expert Advisor” you should have reviewed the following two (2) written documents and/or video tutorials:

1. Getting Started

2. Running the TT-Installer

You are now ready to setup the TT-HedgeHunter Expert Advisor on your MT4 Forex trading platform. Please check to make sure that you have the AUD/CAD currency chart loaded into the graph area of your platform.

Please note that U.S. subscribers willing to assume more risk for potential gains may also install the AUD/NZD chart in order to run both currency pairs on their platform. You will find additional information on running two (2) pairs in the TT-HedgeHunter Manual.

Once you have your currency chart/charts in place you will now attach the Expert Advisor to the MT4 trading platform. You will find the TT-HedgeHunter EA in the “Navigator” section of the trading platform.

Click on the +/- icon on the Expert Advisors tab to display the menu. You should now see the HedgeHunter EA.

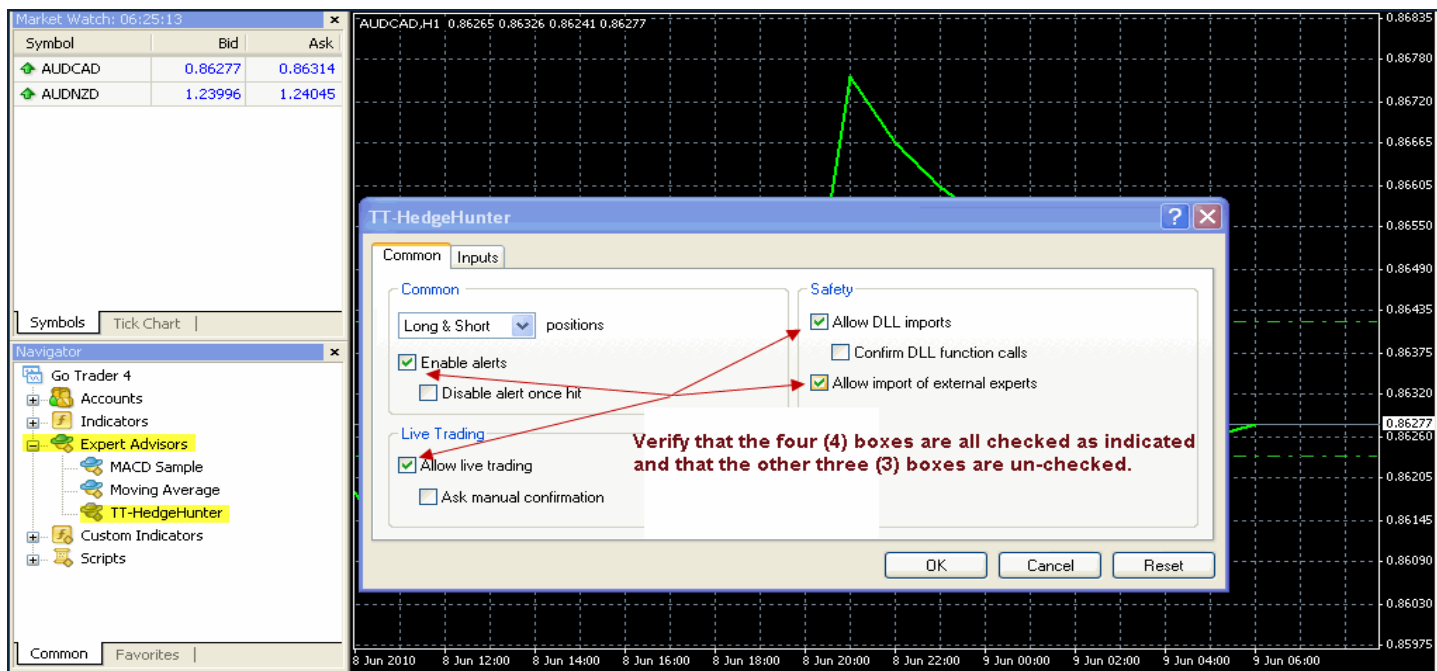
Left click and drag the HedgeHunter EA on to the AUD/CAD chart and drop it anywhere on the graph.

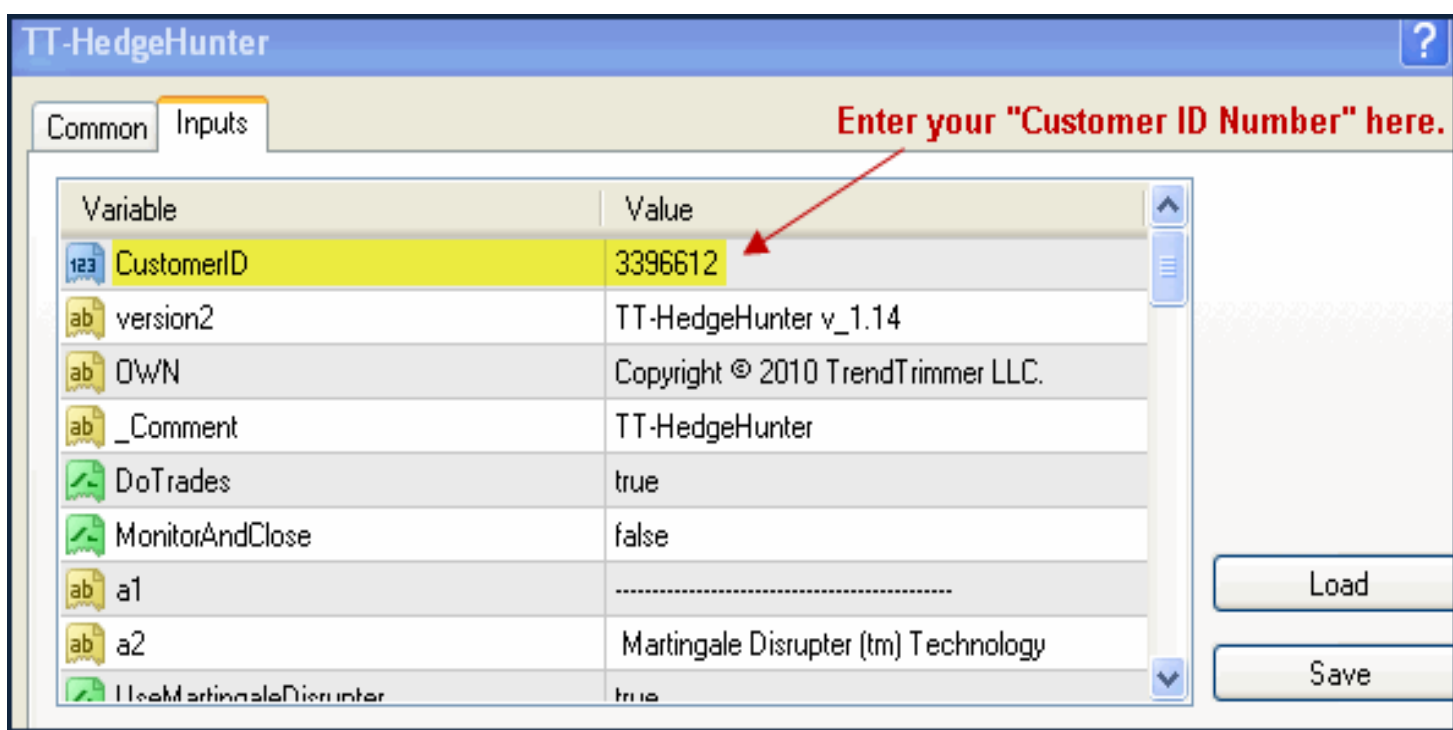
Click on the TT-HedgeHunter EA icon and, with your left mouse button depressed, drag the EA file anywhere onto the chart and then release your mouse button and drop the file into the chart. The “Settings” box will appear. If you are running two (2) pairs you will need to repeat this process for each pair.



Please verify that the four (4) boxes indicated under the “Common” tab have been checked and then click on the “Inputs” tab in order to change the settings required in that section.

Please Note: If the Expert Advisor data box disappears from the chart, you can restore it by clicking on the F7 key.

You will notice that the first entry that you will need is your “Customer ID” number that you received via eMail when you first subscribed to the TT-HedgeHunter, so you will need to locate that information before you’ll be able to proceed.



Locating your Customer ID number

You should have received an email from the TrendTrimmer support team containing your customer ID number. You will need to enter the Customer ID number in the “Inputs’ section of the data box.

NOTE: Please **DO NOT** enter the Expert Advisor’s serial number in this field.

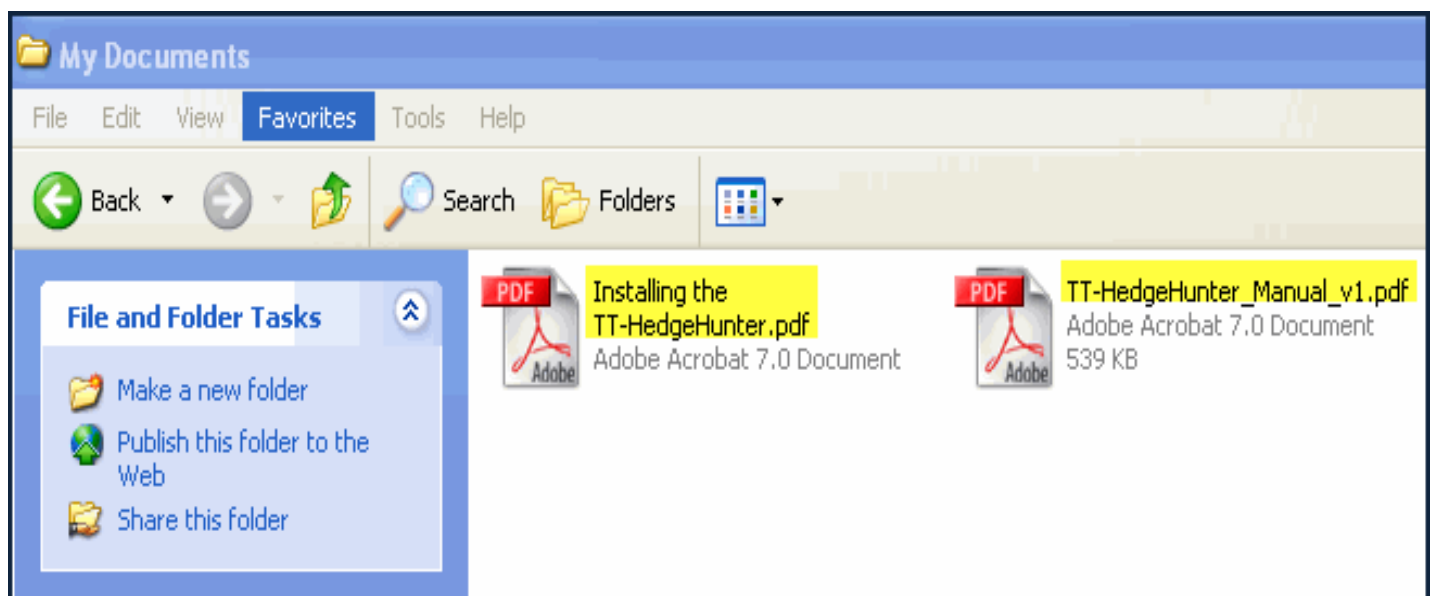

You will also find that the “TT-HedgeHunter Manual” and the “Installing the TT-HedgeHunter” written tutorial were placed in your “My Documents” folder when you ran the TT-HedgeHunter EA Installer.



It may be helpful to print out the fourteen (14) page TT-HedgeHunter user manual in order to review the “Presets” that we have provided for both U.S. and Non-U.S. subscribers. The TT-HedgeHunter manual also contains an in-depth explanation of the Martingale theory as well as the purpose of the Martingale Disrupter™.

Next, we will need to review and enter the remainder of the TT-HedgeHunter EA settings and while it may appear that there are numerous data fields that need to be modified, the majority of them can be left at their initial default setting.

In addition, we have created some “HedgeHunter Presets” that you will be able to load when you’re installing the HedgeHunter EA, if you’re comfortable with those particular settings.

Please note that U.S. subscribers and Non-U.S. subscribers must use “Completely” different settings when running the TT-HedgeHunter expert advisor, so double check to MAKE SURE that you are using the correct settings for your jurisdiction.

TT-HedgeHunter presets for U.S. Subscribers:

The presets listed below are for U.S. subscribers or any subscriber that has opened their Forex Metatrader 4 trading account with a U.S. Forex broker like www.ibfx.com or www.forex.com

We have labeled the presets for TT-HedgeHunter presets for U.S. subscribers as follows:

1. **audcad_nfausa** (Use for the AUD/CAD currency pair)
2. **audnzd_nfausa** (Use for the AUD/NZD currency pair)

Be very cautious with your “TradeLot” or “LotsCalcFactor” settings because they control the size of each trade that the EA opens. If you are too aggressive with these settings you could end up over-trading your account and get a margin call from your broker.

In addition, trading an account with less than \$5,000 should be considered more aggressive than those trading above that amount.

Please note that no settings should ever be considered **“Completely Safe”** and it’s important for you to constantly monitor the margin level of your account. We have done extensive forward and back-testing to determine the settings that have worked best over the past 2-3 years and the best results have been generated with the use of the AUD/CAD currency pair.

U.S. subscribers willing to assume more risk could also trade the AUD/NZD currency pair in an effort to increase their overall returns.


TT-HedgeHunter presets for Non-U.S. Subscribers:

The two presets listed below are for Non-U.S. subscribers and they are labeled as Moderate and Moderate/Aggressive.

As previously mentioned, we **DO NOT** have a preset labeled “completely safe” and as usual the standard TrendTrimmer LLC Forex disclaimer applies.

We have done extensive forward and back-testing to determine the settings that have worked best over the past few years and the best results have been generated with the use of the AUD/CAD currency pair and that’s why we’re providing our Non-U.S. subscribers with presets for that pair only.

Once again, be very cautious with your “TradeLot” or “LotsCalcFactor” settings because they control the size of each trade that the EA opens. If you are too aggressive with these settings you could end up over-trading your account and invite a margin call from your broker.

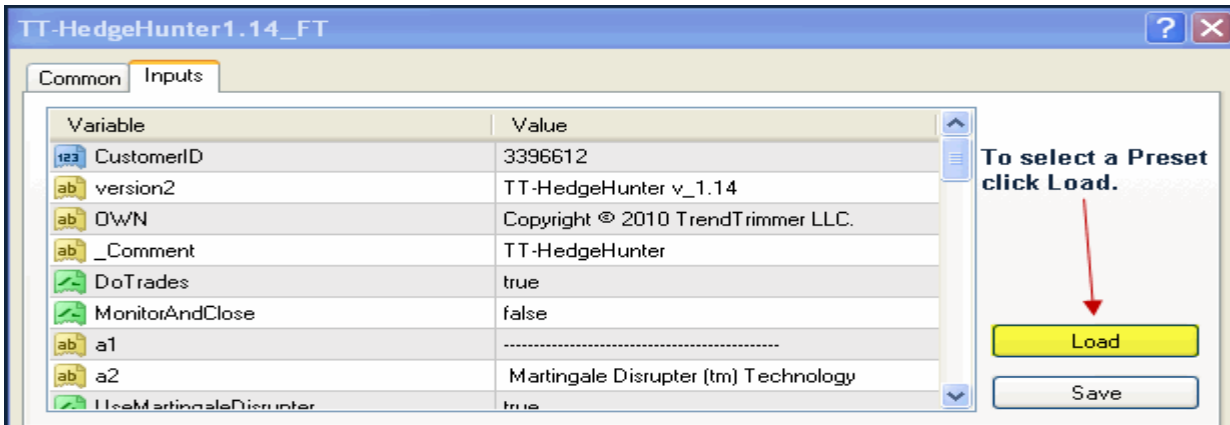

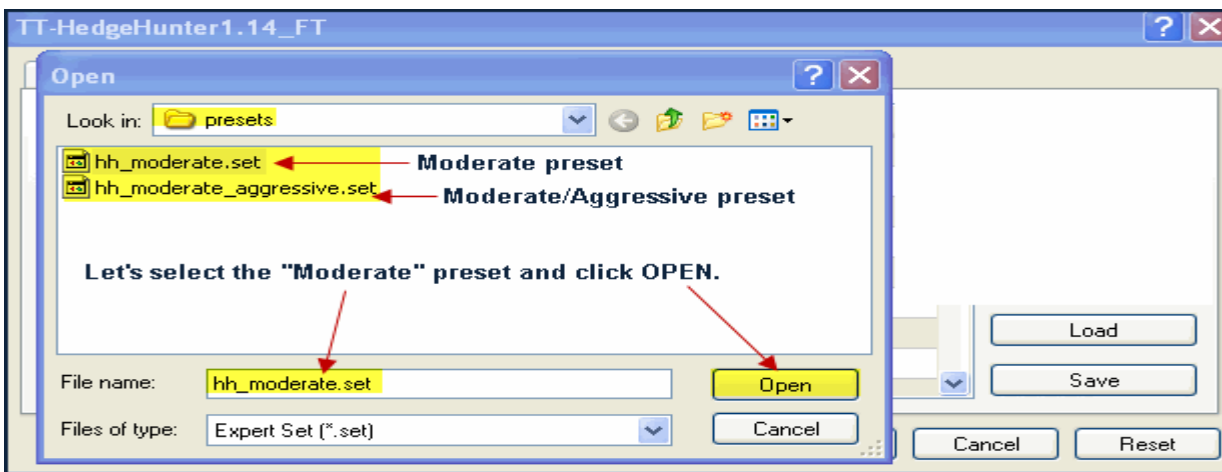

In order to use the TT-HedgeHunter presets, you will need to do the following....

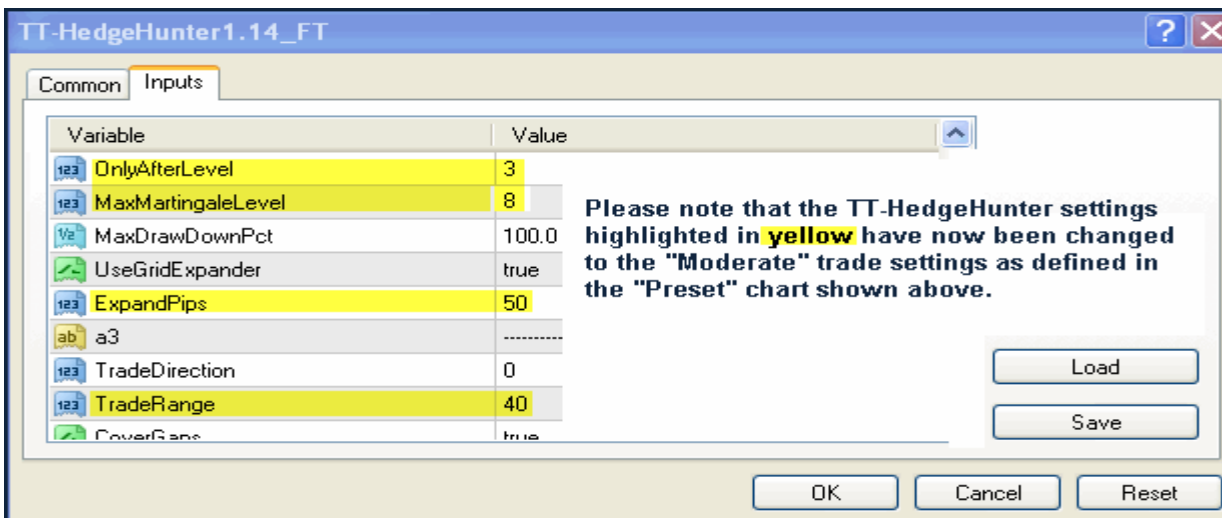
1. Click **LOAD** on the right-hand side of the settings box.



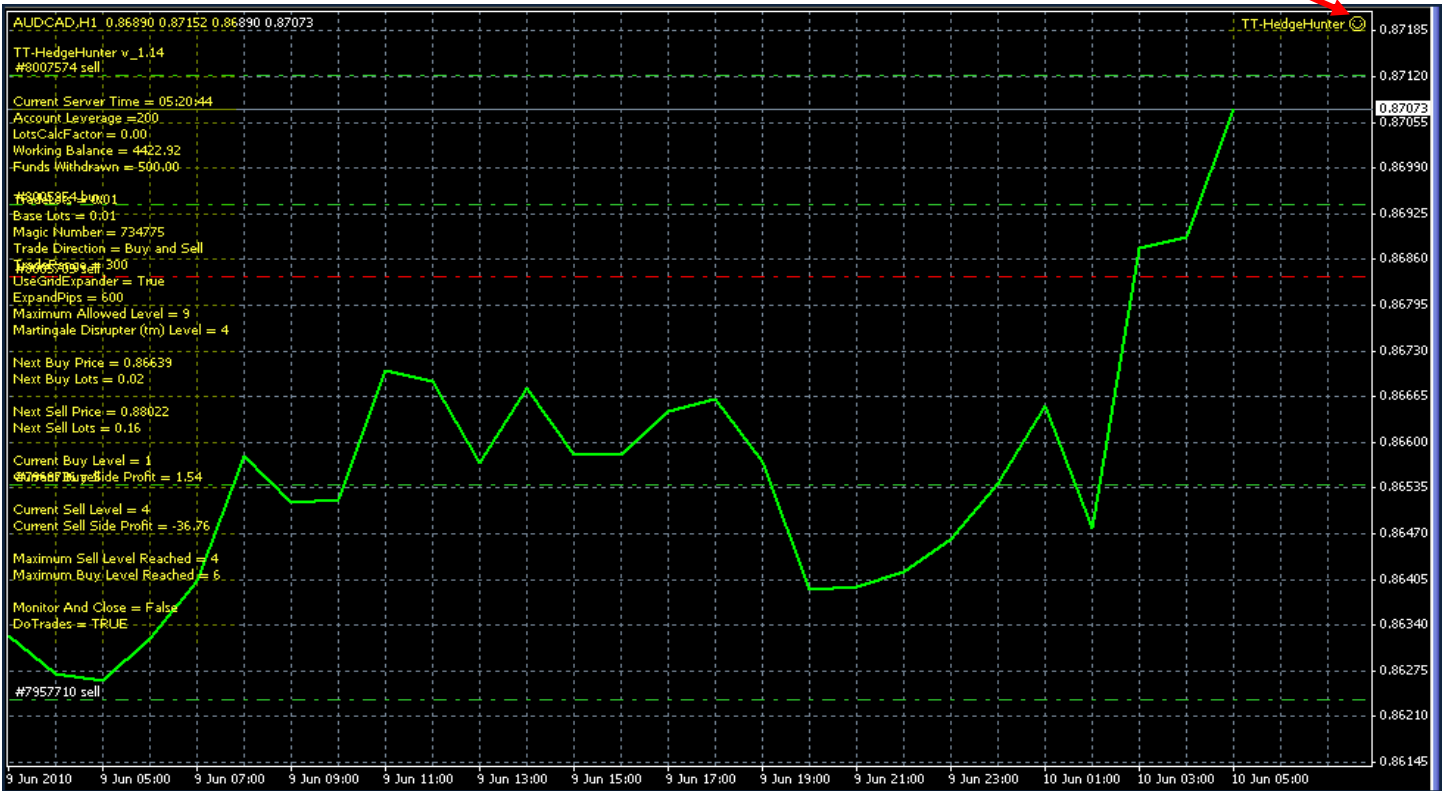
2. A secondary window will open and you will be able to select the TT-Hunter "Preset" of your choice. In this example, we've chosen the Non-U.S subscriber "Moderate" settings preset and clicked Open and then OK on the first window to begin trading the TT-HedgeHunter Expert Advisor.



3. The TT-HedgeHunter is now running and it will immediately begin placing trades.



You should now see the TT-HedgeHunter information displayed on the upper left-hand side of the screen and a “Smiley Face” 😊 in the upper right hand corner of the chart. Smiley Face here...



However, if you DO NOT see a smiley face you should be able to click on the Expert Advisors tab above the chart area to correct the problem.



The TT-HedgeHunter EA will run day and night without any effort on your part, as long as your computer is running and your trading platform is open. If your computer shuts down for any reason, your open trades would be able to close if they hit their Take/Profit settings, but the TT-HedgeHunter will not be able to open any new trades while your PC is offline.

If you're not comfortable leaving your computer running during the trading week, you may consider using a (VPS) virtual private server. A virtual private server will allow you to remotely host your forex trading platform and access your account from any computer.

We offer a "Turn-key" VPS service at the TrendTrimmer which makes it very easy for subscribers to begin trading with any one of the TrendTrimmer EAs. With our service you will simply open and fund your LIVE MT4 Forex account, subscribe to one of our expert advisors with VPS, and then we take it from there.

You should periodically check your platform to make sure that your Expert Advisor is running properly (Opening and Closing trades), your margin percentage is in a safe range and you have a Smiley Face 😊 on your currency chart.
